

Booking 2008

Circelation is a strategic initiative for circus artists to work in collaboration with other performance artists to develop each others performance vocabulary, networks, and to allow them the opportunity to play with other circus artists. During 2008 there will be three different week-long performance laboratories taking place in St Albans, Liverpool and Sheffield.

The 2008 programme follows on from a successful pilot programme in Sheffield in 2000, which was funded by Yorkshire Arts, Sheffield City Council and The Baring Foundation, and further programmes in 2004-2006 in Leeds, funded by Arts Council England, the Esmee Fairbairn Foundation (2004) and the Jerwood Foundation (2005, 2006). The current programme has been funded by the Arts Council England and is presented in association with Contact (Manchester), The New Wolsey Theatre (Ipswich), Merseyside Dance Initiative (MDI), the LEAP Festival and Liverpool 08.

Circelation 2008 will bring together leading names from the theatre/dance and performance world in a series of practical workshops fusing circus skills and theatre practice. The aim is to nurture a collaborative way of working and to develop a language between naturally partnered art forms.

Circelation was developed in response to circus artists needs and we do hope that you will grab this opportunity and take away lots of food for thought. Our longer term aim is to boost artists who will be the future of British Circus and to encourage a broader and more diverse range of high quality product.

Criteria

- 1 You must have been a practising professional performer for at least two years.
- 2 You must be able to clearly prove the impact this course will have on your artistic development
- 3 Priority will be given to artists based in England but we have a small number of places reserved for artists from other UK regions.
- 4 You do not need any previous theatre experience or training but you should be keen to learn from others and willing to share your knowledge and talent
- 5 Please enclose a full CV
